

The Forensics of Legal Fraud

Volume 2 released “On the Unscrupulousness of White Collar Criminals
who Turned a Millionaire into a Vexatious Litigant with a Civil Restraint Order



Paulette H Cooper¹ is a most remarkable woman of spirit and humour, despite the most horrendous experiences that she suffered from men on their own and as part of so-called respectable professions, authorities and institutions.

Her story is riveting reading as it unfolds from the viciousness of a womanizer who also tries to be a business man, but only by stealing, deceiving and being violent.



He was colluding with his mates at the police, the courts and accountancy offices. Thanks to this collusion, Paulette lost the company that she built over ten years as it was liquidated fraudulently. She also lost the Mansion that she restored with her money and nearly her sanity. For Royston Rogers who eventually committed suicide, with the aide of his mates, took from Paulette everything he could: a set of barns for just 20% of their worth, the proceeds of Inkersall Manor, with the assistance of Richard Savill, Setley Wilson and Actons Solicitors. She also lost a series of barns which had planning for a hotel at that time.

But that was not enough: when she started a new life in Nottingham, she was hounded and terrorised again by his associates, liquidator Richard Savill and Sentley Wilson solicitors. Hence she moved to Lincolnshire and bought barns to convert them into three homes but converted them to a hotel when they failed to sell as houses. Still, they ensured that she was bankrupted for a non-existing debt. Insolvency Practitioners acted unlawfully and simply took what should have been hers, protected by the police again. A plot of land was then charged upon in that bankruptcy by CRG Insolvency when they knew full well that she had not had the loan that was the supposed cause for bankruptcy – another fraud.

One of the major players were HBOS who were purportedly behind the *Vavasseur Fraud*² and who had caused her to be unable to claim her losses for Alan White's wrongful accounting. For they used him as a front man for the Vavasseur Fraud and he was imprisoned as a result. When his insurers refused to pay out, HBOS then unlawfully repossessed two of the three barn conversions, after she was clobbered with the malicious *Civil Restraint Order* and could not defend herself in court as a result.

The photos of the raid were published on *Victims Unite!*³, as one of many fraudulent home repossessions and bankruptcies. Hers was one of four sample cases that were presented to the Lord Chancellor Kenneth Clarke QC MP and the Business Minister Vincent Cable MP.

In terms of human cruelty and violence, **Paulette H Cooper**'s experiences are bound to top the list of white collar crimes. The common denominator with **Mr Ebert**'s bankruptcy is that they both were labelled 'vexatious litigant' and were slapped with a 'civil restraint order' to prevent them from fighting for their rights and compensation.

Mr Ebert's experiences are the subject of *Volume 1⁴* of *The Forensics of Legal Fraud* that set the mould for *Volume 2*: a personal account with all the evidence required to demonstrate how institutions don't have a conscience but lie, falsify evidence and just do what they want.

These samples of "white collar crime" will be the subject of discussion, as the Government promises that its *Economic Crime Agency* will take white collar crime as seriously as any other.

However, Victims do wonder whether their concerns will be covered:

- regarding victims of fraud and legal oppression
 - there is no effective remedy for criminal actions by lawyers, solicitors and barristers
 - there is no access to justice, let alone a fair trial
 - litigants in person are a thorn in the eye of the legal profession, and are given an undue hard time
- regarding the legal profession:
 - the Rule of Money is more important than the Rule of Law
 - decisions, affecting the victim, are taken despite the victim's excused absence
 - overcharging seems to be standard practice
- with respect to complaints procedures
 - the Police is unwilling to investigate white-collar criminal activities
 - the Law Society's Legal Complaints Service (LCS) seems to exist mainly to protect its members
 - the Serious Fraud Office (SFO) is as ineffective as the Police in its investigations
 - reporting of fraud is so complex that *Early Day Motion 516⁵* has been tabled to bring the issue to the attention of Parliament
- with respect to the funding of justice
 - public funds serve to feed the legal profession, but not to pay restitution to victims.

Besides Austin Mitchell MP, Chairman of the *Forum for Stable Currencies*, Nic Dakin MP, Pat Glass MP, John McDonnell MP, John Hemming MP and a researcher for Caroline Lucas MP as well as Lord Sudeley, co-founder of the Forum and Lord Ahmed, the current host, have expressed their support.
